

CCA/SDUHSD 2017 Online Health Orientation



Online Health and ISPE

- All students in the San Dieguito Union High School District (SDUHSD) must complete a Health course requirement to graduate and earn a diploma from our district
- If your student has applied for Independent Study Physical Education (ISPE) for the 2017-2018 school year, applications will be reviewed thoroughly and notification of approval or denial will be finalized by the end of June at the latest
- As part of the SDUHSD Summer Online Health Program, students who have applied for ISPE for the 2017-2018 school year and have not completed the Health requirement must attend a MANDATORY orientation for the Summer Online Health course (that is why you are here)
- **Be sure to sign in today or you will not be eligible for Online Health**

Online Health

- The standard way to meet this requirement is for 9th-grade students to complete Year One P.E., which incorporates Health in the course
- The Summer Online Health Program will not require students to attend class during the summer
- They can complete the course from home or anywhere where they can access the online curriculum
- This orientation will provide your student with important information about the SDUHSD Summer Online Health Program and the expectations for its completion
- Students who use an **outside program** to meet the Health requirement this summer must provide proof of completion by **August 11, 2017**
- **Failure to do so will result in the student being placed in Year One PE for the 2017-2018 school year**

The Contract

- This signed contract must be submitted by email, mail, or fax by **Thursday, June 15, 2017**
- Failure to submit the completed contract by the **Thursday, June 15, 2017** deadline **will result in removal from the course for the 2017 summer session**

The Contract

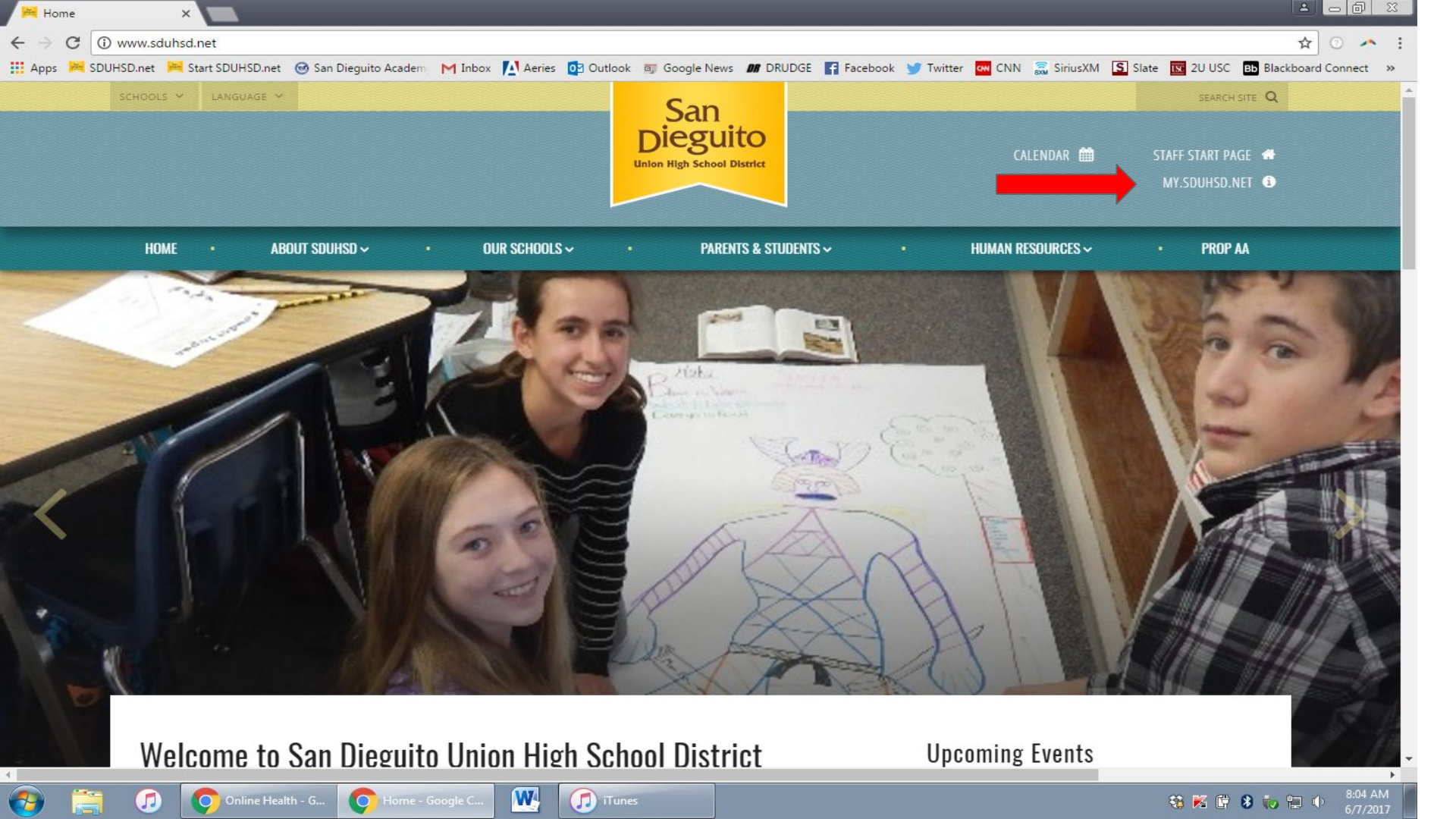
- Students who submit completed contracts by **June 15, 2017** will have access to the course content by **June 23, 2017**
- This contract must be signed and returned by student and parent/guardian before coursework can be started
- The email address submitted on the contract will be the email where communications regarding the course will be sent

The Course Requirements

- The Summer Online Health course will run from **June 23, 2017 through July 21, 2017**
- The Summer Online Health course is an independent study program
- This course is an optional educational alternative that is voluntarily selected in lieu of classroom instruction
- Students in the Summer Online Health course must score at least 70% on each test and quiz in the course by the **July 21, 2017** deadline to meet the SDUHSD Health graduation requirement. Students may take each test up to three times
- Students must review all of the course content for each unit of the course. The program will not allow students to bypass the material and only take the tests

The Dates

- Incoming 9th grade students who do not complete Summer Online Health by **July 21, 2017** will be placed in Year 1 PE for their 9th grade year
- Students will not be granted an extension to the course completion deadline of **July 21, 2017**
- NO EXCEPTIONS

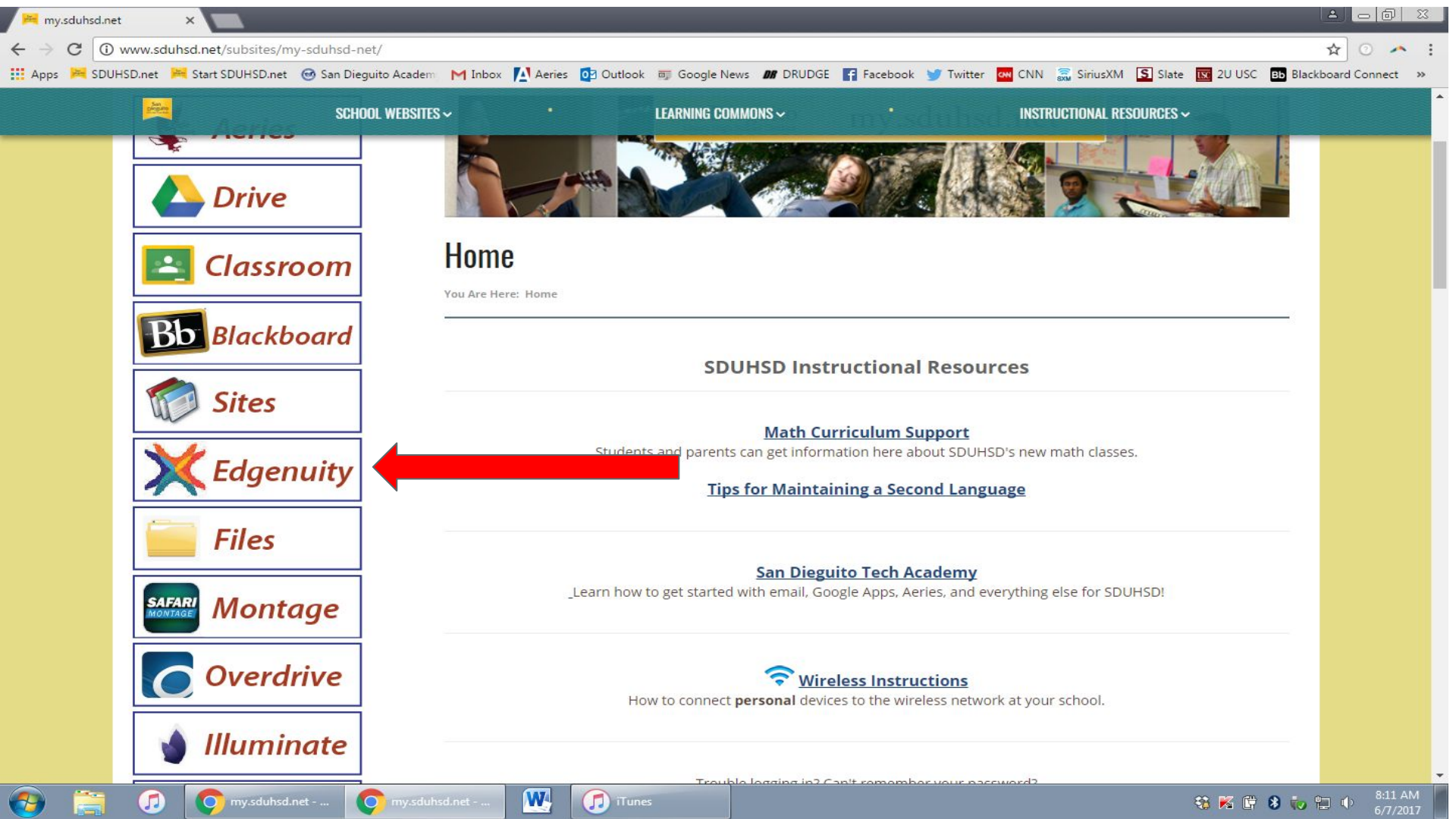
