### How do I enter CCA classes and grades?

Choose semester system. Each of your classes=2 final grades/10 credits, except Gov & Econ = 1 grade/5 credits each.

<u>Example</u>

First Semester (Fall/1st term) AP Gov 5 credits AP Econ 5 credits Statistics 10 credits Acting I 10 credits Yearbook 10 credits Second Semester (Spring/2nd term) English 12 10 credits Physics 10 credits Pop Culture 10 credits Yearbook 10 credits

### How to list Calc III and Linear Algebra on College Apps?

College: College of Extended Studies at San Diego State University, so use that option if it is available otherwise use San Diego State University

Calculus III = SDSU Math 252 (4 semester units)

• Functions of several variables. Vectors. Partial derivatives and multiple integrals. Line integrals and Green's Theorem

Linear Algebra = SDSU Math 254 Introduction to Linear Algebra (3 semester units)

 Matrix algebra, Gaussian elimination, determinants, vector spaces, linear transformations, orthogonality, eigenvalues, and eigenvectors.

### How do I report test scores in my applications? (Plus send official score reports from College Board & ACT.)

Example:

SAT Dec 2016 SAT 680 Math 650 Reading 670 Writing AP May 2017 Spanish Language 4 \*if you have a future test date planned

### Where/when do I get a transcript?

<u>UC/CSU</u> – No transcript required at the time of application unless a specific campus states otherwise.

## CCA Frequently Asked College Application Questions

<u>Common App</u> – Transcripts will be sent via Naviance by your counselor if your list is accurate and your Common App and Naviance accounts are matched.

<u>Non-Common App. & Non UC/CSU</u> – Fill out a request for an official transcript from the registrar and include a stamped envelope addressed to the college with no return address.

#### When do I need an envelope?

For non-Common App colleges or scholarships which require a letter of recommendation and/or transcript which cannot be submitted electronically.

For Letters of Recommendation, provide your teacher(s)/counselor with FERPA, the appropriate paper forms and a stamped envelope addressed to the college with no return address.

For transcripts only, fill out a request for an official transcript from the <u>CCA Registrar</u> and include a stamped envelope addressed to the college with no return address.
