Students who have not registered for Naviance can login by clicking *I need to register* and entering the student ID# for New User. Parents may login by entering the student's ID# followed by a letter *p* (ex: 123456p). For returning users who forget passwords, click the *forgot your password* link on the Naviance page. MARK YOUR CALENDAR FOR JANUARY

PSAT SCORES: If your 9th and/or 11th grade student participated in taking the PSAT in October, they will receive their results next week during 2nd period. Students with an unscheduled 2nd period will be called in during the course of the day and handed results directly.

1/03 – [AP Exam Registration](#) is open. Regular registration runs through March 17, 2017. Regular registration cost is \$111 per exam (administrative costs included). Late registration runs through March 28, 2017. Cost per exam during late registration is \$145. No orders will be accepted after March 28. No student will be excluded from taking AP tests in SDUHSD due to financial concerns. AP Fee Reduction applications are available but must be applied BEFORE the deadline for registration. **The deadline for AP Fee Reduction applications is March 14, 2017.** Students who wish to request an AP Fee Reduction application should contact CCA AP Bernard Steinberger. 1/17 – **Spring Term Course Change Request: The advance window to request class changes for spring term is January 17-20.** Students may submit a class change request form for the following:

- Level changes between College Prep. and Honors /AP
- Adding an academic intervention class
- Repeating classes that a student has not passed
- Adding a class to meet high school graduation requirements or for college eligibility requirements.
- Dropping a class for a free period
- Switching electives within the same period only; **very** limited availability due to master schedule.

The required form will be posted to the Counseling website on Jan. 17 (Parent signature is required – please print at home and obtain signature prior to turning in to Counseling.)

Please note, the spring master schedule is in progress and there may still be changes to periods and alternates. Counselors are not able to address spring term schedule change requests by phone or email.

All other course change requests will be addressed during the two-week add/drop period.

1/27 Final Exams (Periods 3 & 4); School dismisses at 12:25 PM; 2nd Quarter Ends.

REMINDERS FOR SENIORS

Please use the 4-Year College Checklist and the College App (by type) Guide, both available in Naviance, to make sure that you don't miss any application steps. Reminders:

- Make sure to send official SAT or ACT scores to all colleges to which you are applying.
- Pay careful attention to all emails and instructions from each college. They may request additional materials or note that they have not received required items.
- Teachers and counselors are *not* notified of any changes to your Naviance or Common App college lists. If you need to make changes, you must see your teacher(s)/counselor in person to follow-up.

- **Withdrawing Apps After ED Admission:** When students apply under an Early Decision plan, they agree to withdraw their applications to other colleges if admitted. To do this, students must contact these other colleges directly. **To withdraw or cancel a UC application, contact each school per instructions [here](#).** The Common Application does not have a mechanism for withdrawing submitted applications. (Students seeking financial aid do not need to withdraw other applications until they have received notification about financial aid from the admitting Early Decision institution.) College applications cannot be deleted or canceled in Naviance, but students who commit to an ED school should notify their counselor and teachers, set their attending college and update results in Naviance.
- **Update your Naviance account as you receive admissions decisions.** To edit/update, click on the pencil icon next to any college under *Colleges I'm Applying to*, select the decision from the drop-down menu, and click *update* at the bottom of the page.

COLLEGE ADMISSIONS TESTING INFORMATION

SAT January 21, 2017 is the next test date for the SAT and SAT Subject Tests. **Regular registration is closed. Late registration closes January 10, 2017.**

ACT February 11, 2017 is the next available ACT test date. Regular registration closes January 13. Late registration closes January 20; late fee applies.

CCA's school code is 050893. Students requiring an SAT/ACT *fee waiver* can obtain one from the Counseling Secretary, or from Ms. Burton in the College & Career Center.
