Course Description

In this course, students refine their understanding of this art form, explore their expressive skills, and build self-awareness and confidence. Students practice improvisation, scene analysis, and character building techniques. Students learn these skills through theatre games, movement exercises, improvisation, scene study, and monologue work.

Other notes:

This course includes guest artists—professional actors and directors—who come into the classroom to teach in their fields of expertise.

Although students coming from other schools may have taken a beginning or intermediate acting course, Envision Theater faculty require that every CCA acting student begin with this course. Because of highly structured Envision acting curriculum, students may not skip this course to move to a higher level. This course is required for Envision Theater Conservatory students.
