## Course Description

Prior to taking the Advanced Recording Arts class, students will need to have successfully completed both the Digital Composition and Recording Arts courses. This course will build on the skills the students learned in these courses and offer lectures and projects based on more advanced audio topics.

The Advanced Recording Arts course will cover professional level concepts including the history of the recording industry and technology, signal flow and use of various recording hardware, advanced audio recording techniques, advanced mixing and editing concepts, advanced mastering, sound reinforcement, music production skills, music business skills, and careers in the recording field. Students have access to industry software (Pro Tools, Reason, Sibellius) as well hardware and microphones needed to complete professional grade recordings. Students will work on largely self-directed recording and audio production projects designed to mirror real world work in this field.

When possible, professionals from the field will be brought in to work with the students and trips to visit professional recording facilities will be arranged. Students will also be advised on internship possibilities and college programs in the recording field.
