Course Description

Students in Advanced Sculpture will be building on the knowledge learned in Sculpture. It is required that students take Sculpture before taking Advanced Sculpture.

This course is project-based and success depends on effort demonstrated by the student to commit to the creative process. Advanced Sculpture is designed to continue an in depth, intensive study of three dimensional art, while practicing and mastering techniques and concepts. The course will be build on sculpture techniques and applying higher level skills to mixed media, clay, plaster, wood, and wire. Students will be introduced to new concepts and learn to problem solve artistic outcomes. Students are required to give peer assessments, presentations, and critiques throughout the course.

Grading

Students are graded in 4 main areas:

Project Preparation:

initial reseach, creating sketches, video/article reviews, artist reviews, and creating protopyes

Art Creation:

craftsmanship, application of skill, use of classroom time, growing and improving artistic skills, photographing and submitting completed assignments

Evaluation: Critiques, self reflections, building portfolios

Studio maintenance/saftly: assisting in maintaining a safe and clean studio enviornment, learning how to properly and safely use tools, learning the clay firing process, clay and glaze preparation
