Course Description

Photo Imaging will take the principles and technical information learned in the Digital Photography course and apply it to a commercial photography curriculum. The profession of photography, rather than the art of photography, is the heart of the course. Students will compile a professional portfolio that focuses on work for clients' needs. Resumes, Web portfolio, interview practice will be covered as well as work related habits and expectations.

Emphasis will be on portraiture, promotion, event photography, product still life, fashion, group photography, architecture, food, and design for advertisements. Students will learn preproduction through postproduction skills with an emphasis on concept and execution of proposed ideas. Weekly output of quick one day assignments as well as longer week long units of work offer students variety of course work and expectations.

Students should expect 1-2 hours per week of shooting time homework.

This course is matriculated with MiraCosta College Art 251 if standards are met by student. (application to MiraCosta College, grade of B or better in course and Final Examination).
