CAL GRANT OPT-OUT FORM - 12th grade students only

Cal Grant gives funds to every eligible senior student who meets the requirement. A Cal Grant pays for tuition, room and board, or books and other supplies for California colleges. Cal Grant applicants must also file the FAFSA or the California Dream Act application between October 1 and March 2, 2018.

Canyon Crest Academy will electronically submit information for every senior in the district to the California Student Aid Commission so they may be considered for a Cal Grant award.

California public high schools are required to submit a Cal Grant high school Grade Point Average (GPA) for all graduating seniors, unless the student or parent has opted out of the submission process, no later than October 1.

Please complete and submit the Cal Grant GPA Opt-Out Form ONLY if you would like to opt-out of Cal Grant's GPA Verification Process.

If you DO NOT wish to have your student's information submitted electronically, please complete the opt-out information form at http://www.csac.ca.gov/pubs/forms/grnt_frm/gpa_opt_out.pdf and either return the completed form to:
