*9-12 GPA at the time of application:	confirm which GPA a college is requesting in application instructions or admissions information, including whether weighted or unweighted

How do I enter CCA classes and grades?

Choose **SEMESTER** system.

Each of your classes = 2 final grades/10 credits, *except American Gov't & Economics = 1 grade/5 credits each.

Example:

First Semester (Fall/1st term)

AP US GovPol	5 credits
AP Econ Macro	5 credits
Stat/Prob	10 credits
Acting I	10 credits
Yearbook	10 credits

Second Semester (Spring/2nd term)

English 12	10 credits
Physics	10 credits
Sociology	10 credits
Yearbook	10 credits

How to list Calc III and Linear Algebra on College Apps?

College: College of Extended Studies at San Diego State University (use this option if it is available)

*otherwise use San Diego State University

Calculus III = SDSU Math 252 (4 semester units)

- Functions of several variables. Vectors. Partial derivatives and multiple integrals. Line integrals and Green's Theorem

Linear Algebra = SDSU Math 254 Introduction to Linear Algebra (3 semester units)

- Matrix algebra, Gaussian elimination, determinants, vector spaces, linear transformations, orthogonality, eigenvalues, and eigenvectors.

How do I report test scores in my applications? (Students must send official score reports from College Board/ ACT)

Example:

SAT June 2018: Read/Write: 710 Math: 650

ACT June 2018: English: 34 Math: 29 Read: 32 Science: 33

AP May 2018: English Language 4

PLANNED: 11/2018*

PLANNED: 11/2018*

5/2019: AP Biology*

*If you have a future test date planned

CCA Frequently Asked College Application Questions

Where/when do I get a transcript?

UC/CSU Campuses – No transcript required at the time of application unless a specific campus states otherwise.

Common Application Colleges – Transcripts will be sent by your Counselor electronically. *Note: You must invite your Counselor via Common App (if you fail to do so, your Common App schools will be missing necessary documents)

Non-Common App. & Non UC/CSU – For Non-Common App college applications which require a paper form to accompany official transcripts, order transcripts in person from the registrar and provide the required college forms with an addressed, stamped envelope with no return address.

For all other transcripts, students can opt to order online via [Parchment](#). Please note: AP exam and college entrance exam scores are not posted on the SDUHSD transcript and must be ordered from College Board or ACT.

When do I need an envelope?

For **Non-Common App colleges or scholarships** which require a Letter of Recommendation and/or transcript which cannot be submitted electronically.
