### **Course Description**

This course is dedicated to helping students create the best college application possible and prepare them for the transition to collegiate life. Students will research universities, explore majors and careers, fill out applications, find money and scholarships to help pay for college, and learn valuable life skills to prepare them for the next chapter of their lives.

Guest speakers include CCA alumni that are currently in college, college graduates from CCA, and members of the community. Invited speakers will share pertinent information on their college experiences, how to navigate life away from home and prepare for the "real world."
