Course Description

The successful student in this advanced course will be able to listen to and discuss news casts in French; express opinions and carry on conversations on social and cultural issues; read and comprehend excerpts of literary works independently; and begin to write compositions in which they organize and defend their ideas. This class is in alignment with national standards at the intermediate-mid level.

Typical activities include watching and analyzing film excerpts; creating a short film in French; watching news clips and reading current-events articles and using them as a springboard for class discussion and writing.

Outside of class, the student will complete exercises in advanced grammar and vocabulary in order to express themselves at a more sophisticated level. In general, the successful student will spend approximately 30–60 minutes on work outside of class to prepare for the next class session.

Assessments include oral presentations dialogues, essays, projects, quizzes and tests.
